

Two women find 20 000 Francs between pillows from one of Zurich's second-hand shops

In the city of Zurich, Switzerland, two women acquired two pillows for garden chairs from a second-hand dealer. When opening their package at home, they were surprised to find an envelope between the pillows. Under Police surveillance it was established that the envelope contained a total of twenty-thousand Swiss Francs. Upon investigation of Police Detectives, the background of that surprising story was clarified.

It turned out that those pillows belonged to the legacy of a deceased lady. The heirs had given away the pillows in the course of house clearance, obviously without noticing the hidden money. Through the honesty of the finders, the money was reimbursed to the heirs which in turn rewarded the finders a share of three-thousand Swiss Francs.
